Batteries are collected at each ward office, Returnable bottles such as beer bottles, sake cleaning centre, public health centre and bottles(1.8litre), and milk bottles should be city hall. Button-type batteries and Ni-Cd returned to the shop from which you bought. PET batteries should be returned to the shop.
